PORTAGE - John W. Mulhern, age 80, of Saddle Ridge, died on Monday, February 9, 1998 at Divine Savior Hospital in Portage. John Wayne Mulhern was born on July 29, 1917 in Buffalo Township, Marquette County, Wisconsin to Bernard and Mary (McIntyre) Mulhern.

On June 14, 1943, he was united in marriage with Roe E. Jerome at St. Andrew's Catholic Church in Buffalo Township. John served in the Philippines during World War II as a member of the United States Army, 96th Ordnance Division.

He had worked at Henry G. Meigs Company in Portage for 37 years, retiring as Vice President. Mr. Mulhern was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Portage and the Knights of Columbus, C.W. Henney Council Fourth Degree member of Fr. Bourgmeier Assembly. He was also a member of the VFW Cleary-Krech Post #1707 and the American Legion Richard W. Mulcahy Post #47.

Survivors include his wife, Rose E. Mulhern of Saddle Ridge; three children; five grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; a brother, Stanley Mulhern of Pardeeville; a sister, Madelyn Lynch of Portage; a son-in-law, Bob Steinman of Beaver Dam; and nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

Mr. Mulhern was preceded in death by his parents; a daughter, Jayne Steinman; and an infant daughter, Rosanne.
