Herrold, Lloyd Wilson Born April 27, 1925, to Lloyd Dallas and Phoebe Wilson Herrold of Evanston, Illinois, died peacefully on August 28, 2010.

Lloyd served in the U.S. Army from 1943 to 1946, primarily in the Philippines.

Although he earned a JD degree from Harvard Law School and was admitted to the bar in 1953, he spent most of his career as a CPA, ultimately joining Peat, Marwick, Mitchell (now KPMG) in 1962, where he served as Tax Partner in the Milwaukee office.

Lloyd devoted much of his life to others through volunteer work. He was President of the Milwaukee Art Museum and Friends of Art, Chair of the Lakefront Festival of Arts, a member of the Wisconsin Arts Board and the board of Arts Midwest, and he served on the boards of the Milwaukee Repertory Theater, St. John's on the Lake, Alverno College, Forest Home Cemetery, and the Minocqua Country Club. In addition, he was a Senior Warden of St. Paul's Episcopal Church and was involved in the Inner City Arts Council, The Gathering, Sojourner Truth House, and Walkers Point Arts Center.

Appreciated for his quick wit, keen intelligence, and kind heart, Lloyd is dearly loved by his family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of over 61 years, Edith Bannon Herrold, and by his daughter Edie and sons Bill and Brad, and their families.
