Charles E. Hoffee, age 92, of West Salem, Illinois, passed away Sunday evening, October 14, 2018, at St. Vincent Hospital in Evansville, Indiana.

He was born January 25, 1926, in Wayne County, the son of Charles Rueben and Mildred Elizabeth (Elliott) Hoffee.

Charles served in the Army 96th Infantry Division during WWII, serving in Okinawa, Guam, Saipan, and the Philippines. He held the honor of being a recipient of the Bronze Star and Purple Heart awards.

He was involved in farming throughout his life and was a security guard in Olney and Fairfield. He was a member of the Lutheran Church, and enjoyed reading and completing many woodworking projects.
