Mr. Ernest William Malkewitz, Jr. of Grand Rapids, Michigan, age 91, passed away peacefully in the early morning hours of Monday, December 19, 2016. He was born to Ernest, Sr. andAva (Watkins) Malkewitz on Friday, July 17, 1925, in Chicago, Illinois. Ernest was a proud Boy Scout, remaining active for over seventy-five years, earning the Silver Beaver Award. He began as a Cub Scout in 1934, and received his Eagle badge in 1943.

He graduated East Grand Rapids High School in that same year, then went on to graduate from Michigan State University with a degree in civil engineering. At nineteen years of age, Ernest proudly and courageously served his flag and country in the United States Army during World War II, in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater. He was decorated with two Bronze Star medals, and Philippian Liberation Medal. He was a part of 96th Infantry Division known as the Deadeyes. Ernest was one of nineteen who survived in his company at Okinawa and received the Presidential Citation.

Ernest went on to work for the Michigan Department of Transportation as a project engineer and retired after thirty-eight years and eight months of service. He was a charter member of both the Aldersgate United Methodist Church and Northeast Grand Rapids Lion's Club. Ernest and Lorraine were very active at Porter Hills it was their community, their family, their home.
